

1. Application rules:

- a. The Company shall uniformly charge the registration fee both in each year when running the process of assessing market demand for incremental capacity and for each cross border interconnection point.
- b. Having settled the registration fee the network user shall be entitled to submit non-binding capacity demand indication for both directions of a cross border interconnection point, let it be conditional or unconditional in line with the Sections (6) - (9) of the Article 26 of the CAM NC.
- c. Network users shall not be charged further administration fees beside the registration fee provided the terms are duly met. The Company shall consider the registration fee as an advance payment as long as the registration fee payment obligation is not determined.
- d. The Company shall issue an advance payment document on the 2nd business day following the submission of the capacity demand indication, the latest and forward it to the e-mail address indicated by the network user in the non-binding market assessment process.
- e. Should the registration fee not be duly settled, the demand indication submitted in the incremental capacity process shall not be taken into account in the process. Having sent the advance payment document, should the advance payment not be settled by the deadline in the subsection a) of the section 2.) herein, the Company shall inform the network user that its demand indication shall not be considered.
- f. The demand indication refused to be considered due to the non-payment of the advance registration fee could be re-submitted up to the registration deadline set by section (6) of the Article 26 of the CAM NC, the re-submitted demand indication shall be taken into account in the process provided the registration fee is duly and timely settled.

2. Payment conditions:

- a. The advance registration fee shall be transferred by the network user to the bank account indicated on the advance payment document within 3 business days.
- b. Once the advance payment is financially settled, the Company shall issue an advance payment invoice in line with the regulations amended from time to time within 8 business days of the settlement.
- c. The network user shall be charged with the registration fee:
 - I. In case all of the conditions bellow are fulfilled:
 - a. based upon the Demand Assessment Report the incremental capacity process is well-founded,
 - b. the economic test of the incremental capacity process is not positive at any offer levels,

- c. the valid binding capacity demand submitted by the network user in the incremental capacity process does not reach the capacity level submitted in the non-binding phase thereof,
the network user shall be obliged to settle the registration fee. The Company shall issue the invoice on the registration fee after the completion of the conditions within 5 business days from which the sum of the advance payment settled already shall be deducted.
- d. The Company shall reimburse the advance payment in the cases detailed below:
- I. Should the Demand Assessment Report as per the Section (2) of the Article 26 of the CAM NC show that there is no well-founded demand, the Company shall reimburse the advance payment to the network user within 5 business days following the publication of the Demand Assessment Report.
 - II. Should the Demand Assessment Report as per the Section (2) of the Article 26 of the CAM NC show that there is a well-founded demand, and the result of the economic test of the incremental capacity process is positive at least at one offer level, the Company shall reimburse the advance payment to the network user within 5 business days following the publication of the result of the incremental capacity process.
 - III. Provided all conditions bellow are fulfilled, the Company shall reimburse the advance payment to the network user within 5 business days following the publication of the result of the incremental capacity process.
 - a. the Market Demand Assessment Report concludes that the incremental capacity process is well-founded,
 - b. the economic test of the incremental capacity process is not positive at any of the offer levels, and
 - c. the valid binding capacity demand submitted by the network user in the incremental capacity process reaches the capacity level submitted in the non-binding phase thereof.
 - IV. Should the Demand Assessment Report as per the Section (2) of the Article 26 of the CAM NC conclude that there is a well-founded demand, and the incremental capacity project will be initiated, but no incremental capacity allocation procedure will run in compliance with the timeline regulated by the CAM NC, the Company shall reimburse the advance payment to the network user within 5 business days after the publication deadline of the capacity auction as per the CAM NC Section (3) of the Article 28.
In case of alternative allocation mechanism the applicable rules are the same as above, with the following modification regarding the timeframe: if the incremental capacity allocation procedure is not published within 3 (three) years counted from the deadline of the submission of the non-binding demand indications, the latest, the Company shall reimburse the advance payment to the network user within 5 business days following the expiration of the three-year time window.

- e. The Company shall not pay interest upon the advance payment, and no charges shall be demanded for the reimbursement thereof either. The Company shall transfer the sum of the advance payment to the bank account communicated by the network user prior to the reimbursement.

Based on the NRA's resolution the registration fee is 3 000 (three thousand) EUR / cross border interconnection point / network user. The approved fee can be found in the original resolution (No. H1617/2021) in Hungarian, which part was copied and highlighted under this section.
